

BYLAW NO. 01-2024

A BYLAW OF THE *Highway 41 Water Utility* OF *Aberdeen, SK* TO ESTABLISH BYLAW 01-2024 Infrastructure Dividend

---

The Board of the *Highway 41 Water Utility* of *Aberdeen*, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

**Section 1: Purpose and Intent**

The purpose of this bylaw is to establish guidelines for the payment of an infrastructure dividend by individuals or entities seeking to connect to the existing water utility infrastructure which was installed in the previous five (5) calendar years and is owned/operated by Highway 41 Water Utility.

**Section 3: Payment of Infrastructure Dividend**

- 1. Calculation:** The fee shall be payable at 10% of the full capital cost when capital costs exceed \$50,000.
- 2. Payment Schedule:** The infrastructure dividend shall be paid in full prior to the issuance of a permit or approval for connection to the water utility infrastructure.
- 3 Disbursement:** Funds collected from the infrastructure dividend shall be collected by Highway 41 Water Utility for disbursement to qualifying subscribers. Funds will be disbursed within thirty (30) calendar days of receipt by Highway 41 Water Utility.
- 4 Adjustments:** Highway 41 Water Utility reserves the right to adjust the infrastructure dividend rates periodically based on updated cost estimates and financial needs of the water utility infrastructure.

**Section 5: Compliance**

Failure to comply with the requirements of this bylaw may result in denial of the connection permit or other enforcement actions as determined by Highway 41 Water Utility.


**Section 6: Severability**

If any provision of this bylaw is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.
